General Statement of Health and Safety


Our policy is to provide and maintain safe working conditions, equipment and systems of work for our employees and to provide such information, training and supervision as necessary for this purpose. So far as is reasonably practicable we accept responsibility for the health and safety of others working on our property, visitors and the general public lawfully using our facilities, taking account at all times of the presence of water and its special hazards.

Appointed contractors will be required to demonstrate their competence, and we shall ensure co-ordination and co-operation between contractors and other users of the Royal Docks.

We recognise our responsibilities under legislation, including the Health and Safety at Work Act 1974 and the Management of Health and Safety at Work Regulations 1999.


The allocation of duties for safety matters, and the particular arrangements which we will make to implement this policy are set out in the Royal Docks Management Authority Health and Safety Management System.
