

Memo: PPE Requirements for RoDMA Staff and Contractors.

Effective immediately, all staff must adhere to the following Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) requirements while working on Royal Docks Management Authority Sites:

1. Minimum PPE Requirements:

- **Toe cap boots** must be worn at all times.
- **High visibility top** must be worn at all times.

2. Lifting Operations:

- When lifting operations are in progress, **hard hats** are mandatory.

3. Marine Works and Dock Edge:

- If you are crossing the yellow line at the dock edge or participating in any marine-related work, you must wear a **lifejacket**.

Additional PPE may be required for a task please ensure you comply with the task-specific risk assessment.

4. Contractors Work Areas:

- RoDMA Staff entering the designated work area for contractor's operations must comply with the PPE requirements in that area.

Please always ensure compliance with these safety measures. Safety is our top priority. Anyone identified as not complying with the correct PPE will suspend the task for 20 minutes while a period of compulsory re-induction will be undertaken. If continued infractions are observed then personnel will be suspended and removed from the site.
